Stream: Dermatology

Cases: Acne/Rosacea & The 5 W's of Contact Dermatitis

- Identify the differentiation between acne and rosacea
- Assess the utility of management strategies for acne and rosacea
- Distinguish grade-specific treatment of acne and rosacea
- Identify when to think about contact dermatitis
- Identify common as well as hidden allergen exposures
- Provide diagnostics and treatment for contact dermatitis

Stream: Neurology

Cases: The Evidence for Medical Marijuana in Epilepsy & Patent Foramen Ovale and Stroke

- Identify the mechanism of medical marijuana in epilepsy
- Recognize when to offer medical marijuana
- Describe the potential adverse affects of medical marijuana
- Identify when PFOs are relevant in stroke patients
- Interpret the evidence: negative and positive trials
- Learn how to discuss this with patients

Cases: Mrs. Simpson's Suffering: a case of pain, nausea & emesis in a woman with metastatic ovarian cancer
